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1 Introduction

Foundation Intelligent Technologies (the Foundation) was established on 25 January 2015, entered in National Court Register on 21 July 2015 under No. 0000567814.

In its activity the Foundation combines the ICT skills of its Founder, Intelligent Technologies S.A. with the science of psychology to deliver "Hopeful People Technology". Our first and particular ambition is based on the growing body of knowledge about the detrimental impacts of mobile ICT on children. The Foundation wishes to use these same technologies to support collaboration between parents and children for the beneficial use of mobile devices and the web-based application "im2be".

In its undertakings, the Foundation is guided by the highest standards of ethics, making every effort to ensure that they are also preserved during research and development.

2.6 Tasks laid down in the charter of the foundation

The objectives of the foundation are supporting of the modern economy and science, in particular the development of informatic society, corporate social responsibility and balanced development and supporting education, children and teens rights, education, culture, art, protection of culture and tradition goods, ecology and protection and promotion of health and social care.

Foundation pursues its objectives by:

- ✓ Initiating and leading programs, social and educational campaigns within the Founder;
- ✓ Leading of journalistic and informative activity, including publishing books and journals, brochures and special prints;
- ✓ Leading and organizing, supporting both organizing and financing, trainings corresponding with the objectives of the foundation;
- ✓ Organizing and financial supporting of research programs, conferences, science and popular science publications, in particular connected with modern ICT development;
- ✓ Conducting charity for improvement of living conditions and development of children and youth, as well as for people coming from economically inferior, underinvested and underdeveloped regions;
- ✓ Organizing and providing organizational, financial and material support to NGO's, schools, educational institutions, hospitals or child care and social welfare homes;
- ✓ Organizing and support for particularly valuable activities in the field of culture and art;
- ✓ Organizing and financial support for socially important initiatives related to the promotion of physical culture and sport;

- a. In 2017 the Founder contracted the first testable version of im2be software for Primary School Students and received the web-based application for testing.
- b. The Foundation launched the application and im2be available without charge from its website for invited families to try.
- c. After analysis of the user experience during the pilot studies of the application, recommendations for improvements to the software were developed and the process of improvement to satisfy the needs of the public was begun before the end of 2017.

The assets of the Foundation were current assets in the amount of PLN 5.081,48, which was made up of short-term receivables in the amount of PLN 811,00 and short-term financial assets in the amount of PLN 4.270.48.

The Foundation's labilities constituted own funds in the amount of PLN 5.081,48, which consisted of a basic fund in the amount of PLN 10.030, A loss from previous years in the amount of PLN 1.901,99 and a net loss in the amount of PLN 3.046,53.
